

**ALL-VIRGINIA
JUNIOR ALL-VIRGINIA
Entry Form and Rules**

Open Div.

1. Owners must be a current member of the Virginia Holstein Assoc. Inc.
2. Entry must be entered in the name of the owner as it appears on the registration papers and be housed in Virginia.
3. No animal can be entered in more than one single class (i.e.) she cannot be entered in dry and milking class.
4. No animal can be entered in more than one group in any group class.
5. Photos must be 5 X 7 and can be either Black and White or Color. No retouched photos will be allowed.
6. Composite picture or individuals pictures will be allowed for group classes. Animals must be identified. If an animal is in a group class but not entered in all-Virginia individual classes, be sure to send a photo of that individual if she is a member of the group.
7. At all times the decision of the show committee will be final. The show committee will select 5 judges plus an alternate.

Junior All-Virginia Rules

1. Must be a member of the Virginia Junior Holstein Association with \$3.00 membership paid by May 1 of the current year.
2. All Holsteins shown in the State of Virginia in the current year and shown by a Virginia Junior Holstein member that meets the requirements in Rule 1 are eligible to be entered in the Junior All-Virginia Contest.
3. All entries must be registered in the name of the junior member by May 1 of the current year and exhibited by the owner recorded on the registration paper. Each entry must be accompanied by 1 (1) 5 X 7 gloss print. See guidelines for pictures on previous page.
4. No placing will be considered unless the junior member is the owner at the time the animal is shown I the respective show.
5. See list of classes above.
6. Mail entries to: Virginia Junior Holstein Association, P. O. Box 340, Midland, VA 22728
7. One entry per form. This form may be duplicated
8. ***A copy of the front side of the registration paper is to be included with this entry***
9. Junior All-Virginia entries will automatically be entered in the All-Virginia Contest. One entry form is all that is necessary for each animal.
